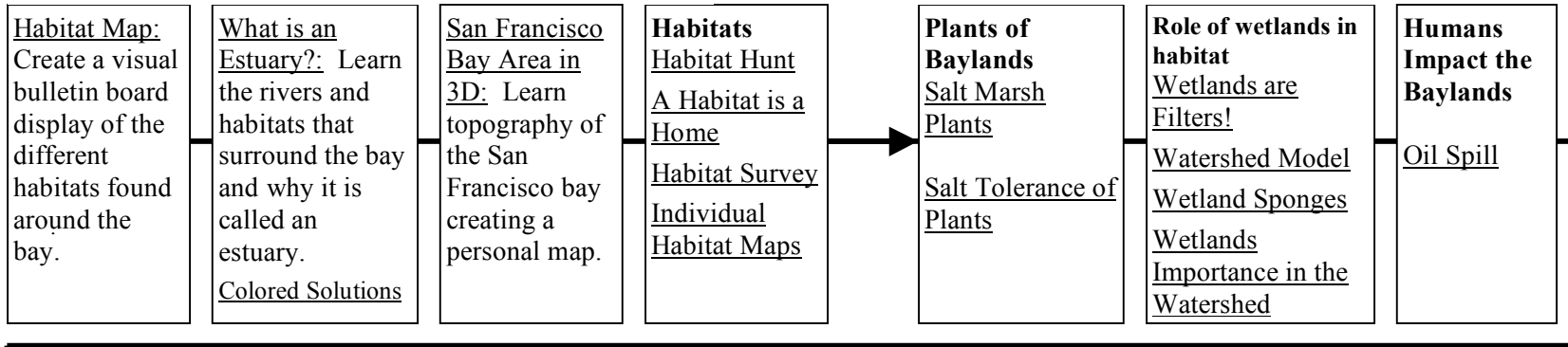


Baylands – Structures of Life

Big Idea: The Baylands includes a variety of habitats – homes for living things which provide the resources they need to survive – air, water, food, shelter and space.

Concept I: An estuary provides a unique collection of aquatic habitats.

Concept II: A Habitat is a home for living things that provides the resources they need to survive – air water, food, shelter and space.



Concept III: Baylands plants and animals are interdependent. They are part of a food web.

Concept IV: Humans can alter a habitat's balance.
